- Support expert time/funding



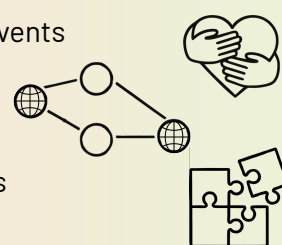
Connect Knowledge to Action
